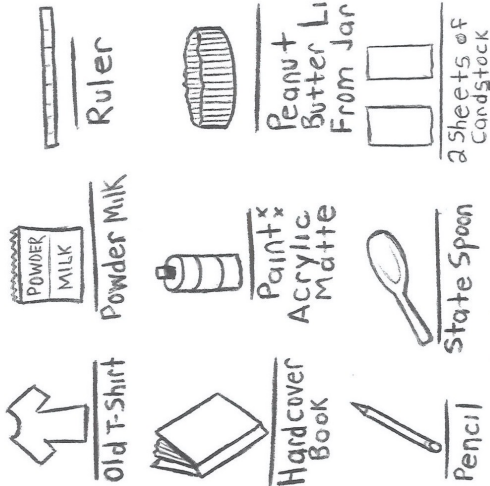


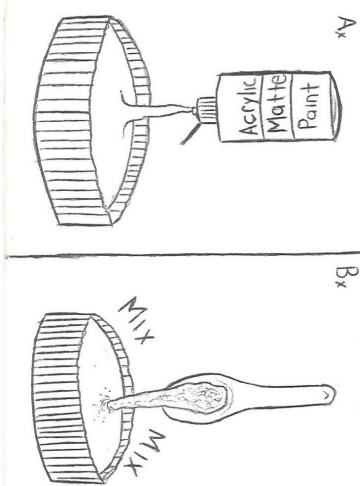
# HOW TO MAKE A

## HOMEMADE CANVAS BOARD

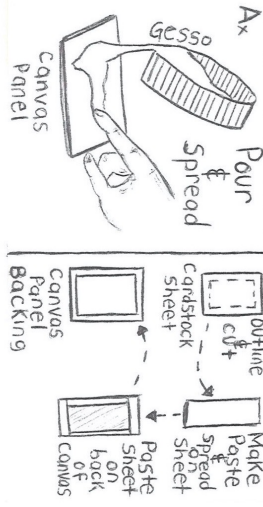
### WITH THESE MATERIALS



### Step 1 - Convicted Art



**Ax)** Clean peanut butter jar lid. Add acrylic paint of your choice (I use beige) into lid. Pour enough paint for both canvas panels.  
**Bx)** Grab your State spoon and Scoop a shot of powder milk adding it onto acrylic paint and mixing it. This will be your gesso.



**Ax)** Pour half of gesso onto surface of the t-shirt part of the canvas and spread it over entire surface using index finger. Consistency should be liquidy and not a paste. Be sure to spread gesso on sides. Let it dry for 30 minutes and add another coat of gesso.  
**Bx)** Cut cardstock to size of canvas panel and use paste to glue it on the back of canvas.

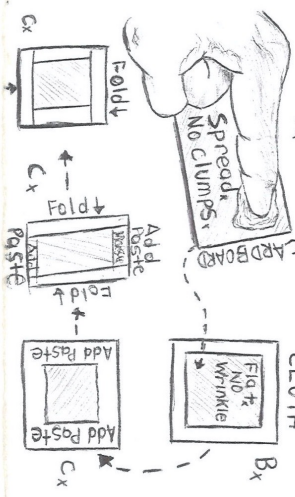
### Handcover Book

**Ax)** Cut the inside edge of the first and last page of the book which are glued to the cover. This will leave all the pages of the book intact.



### Handcover

**Bx)** Tear plastic cover from both cardboards. This may be tedious work depending on how well it's glued down. Yes, take all the plastic cover off on both sides until you are left with two cardboards.

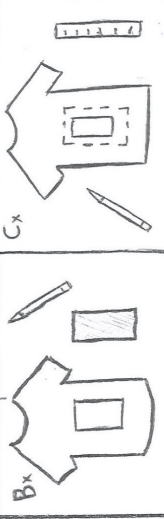


**Ax)** Using your index finger scoop up some paste (if it sticks to your finger it's good consistency if not then it's too watery) and spread it evenly on one side of the cardboard.  
**Bx)** Place the cardboard (paste side down) onto the cloth right on the outline. Press down to edges wrapping cloth over.

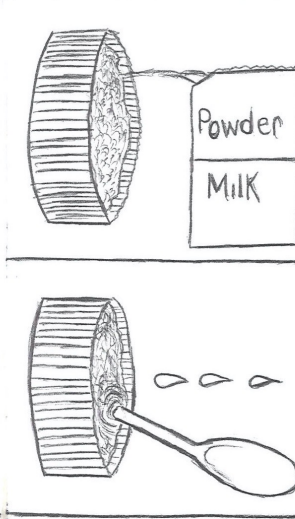
### T-Shirt, Cardboard, Pencil, Ruler

**Ax)** Lay t-shirt on flat surface and place cardboard on t-shirt.  
**Bx)** Use your pencil to outline cardboard on t-shirt and remove cardboard.

**Cx)** Grab ruler and make a larger outline (about an inch over existing cardboard outline).  
**Dx)** Cut the larger outline from the t-shirt using available contraband.  
**Ex)** Repeat A, B, C, D for other cardboard.



**Cx)** These pieces of cloth will serve as your canvas's which you will glue onto your cardboard.



**Ax)** Fill the peanut butter jar lid with powder milk.  
**Bx)** Add small amounts of water on top of powder milk and mix it. Keep adding drops of water and continuously mix it until it turns into a paste. If it gets too liquidy just add more powder milk. This paste will be your glue.
