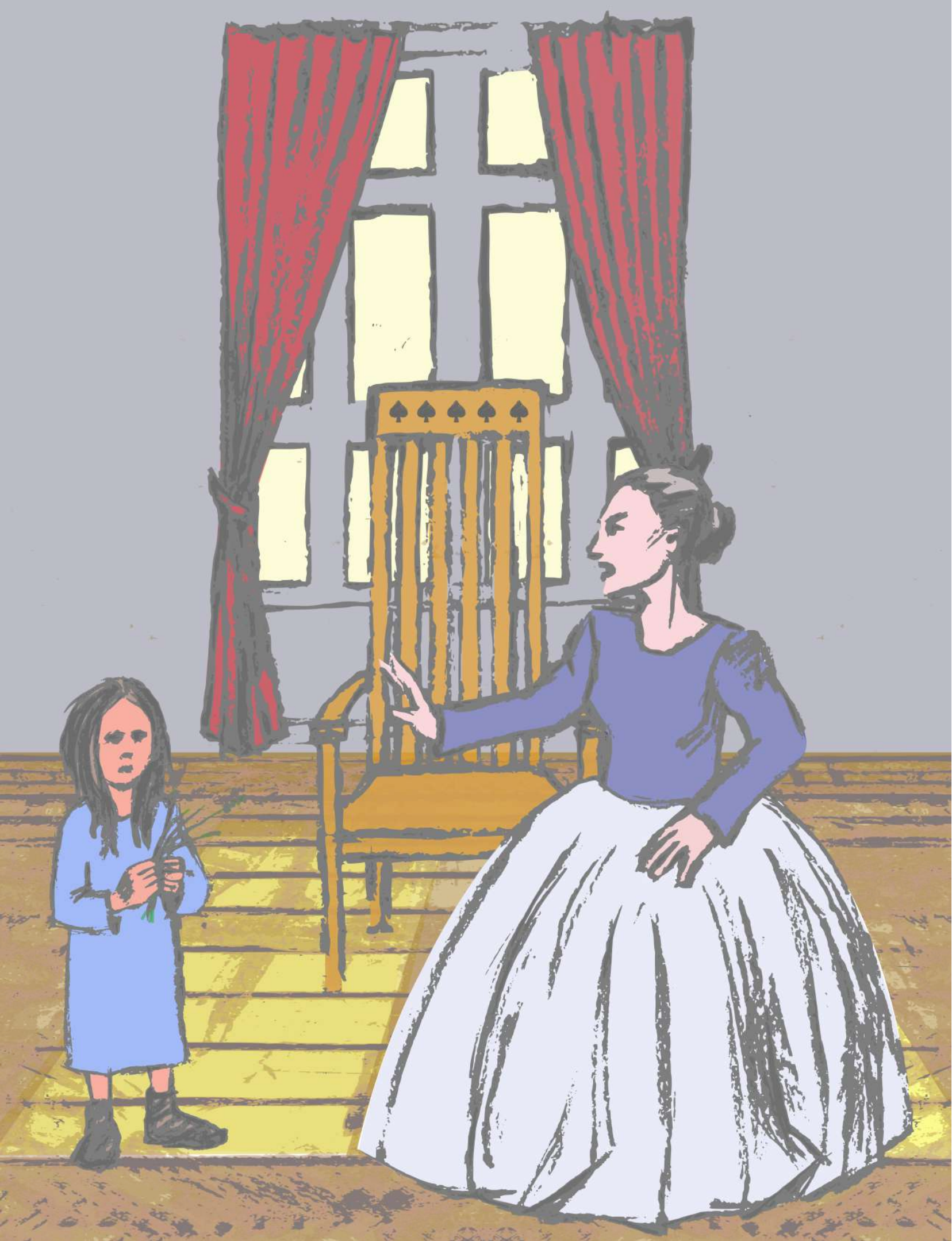

the long grass,



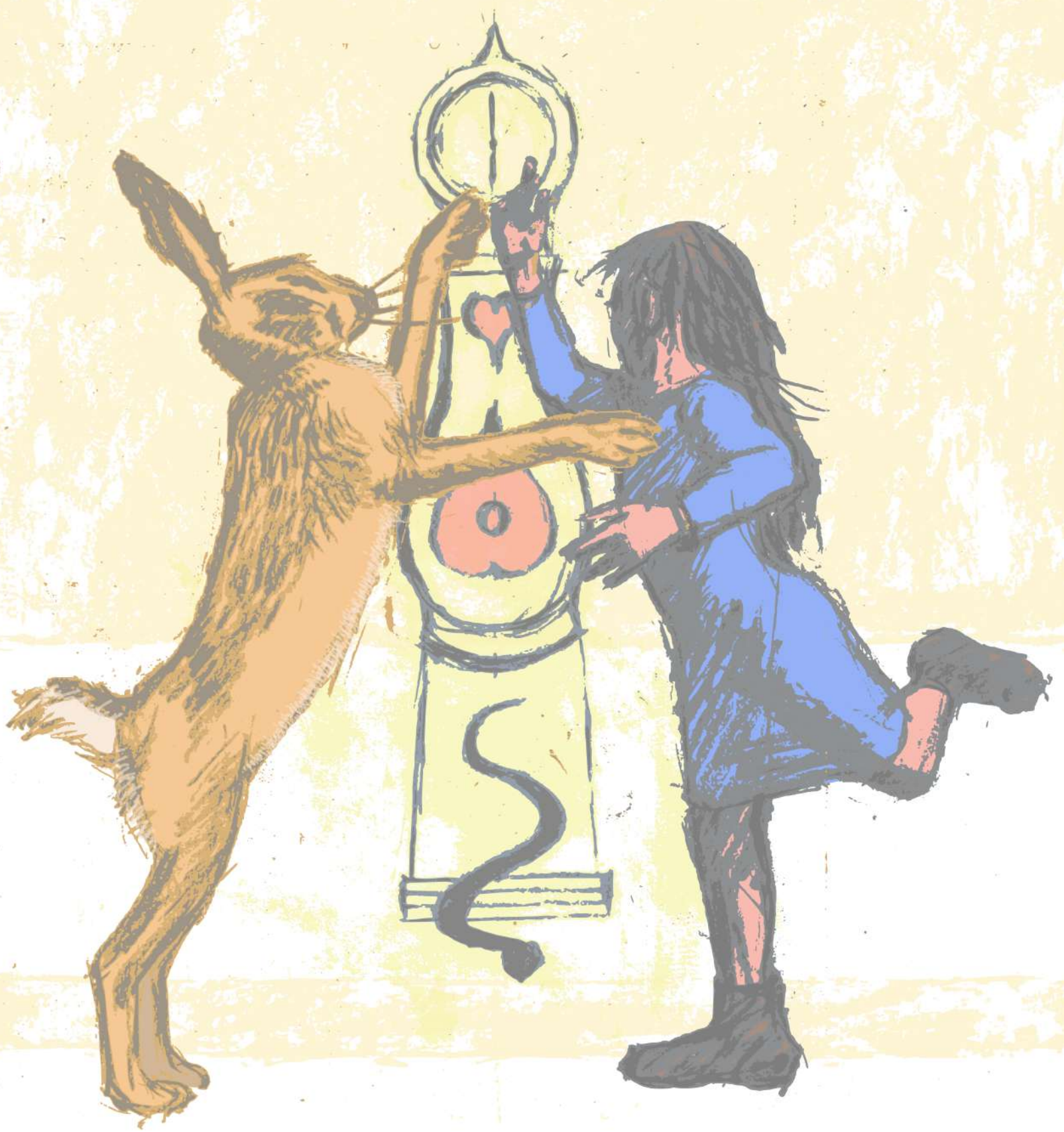
and all through the

to be just the same.

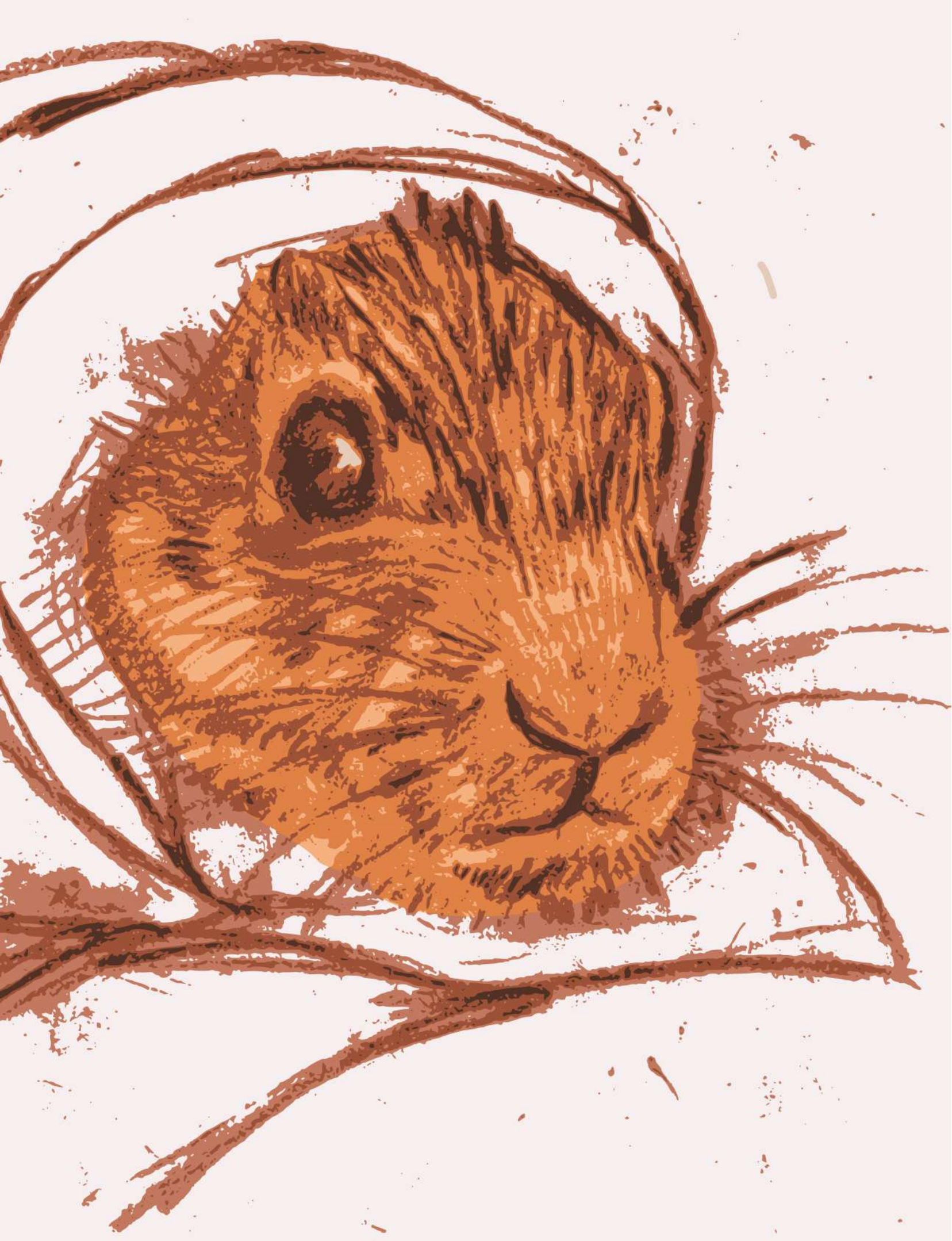


But it wasn't the
