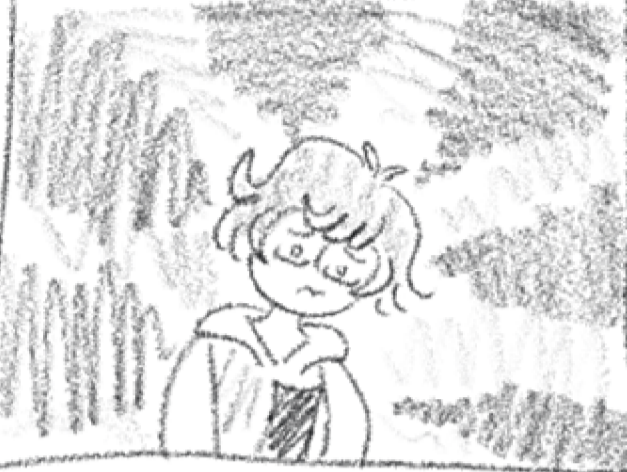


I MET LU KA FOR THE FIRST TIME IN MY 2ND YEAR.

IT WASN'T LONG, THOUGH, UNTIL THIS OTHER COLLEGE KID SHOWED UP.

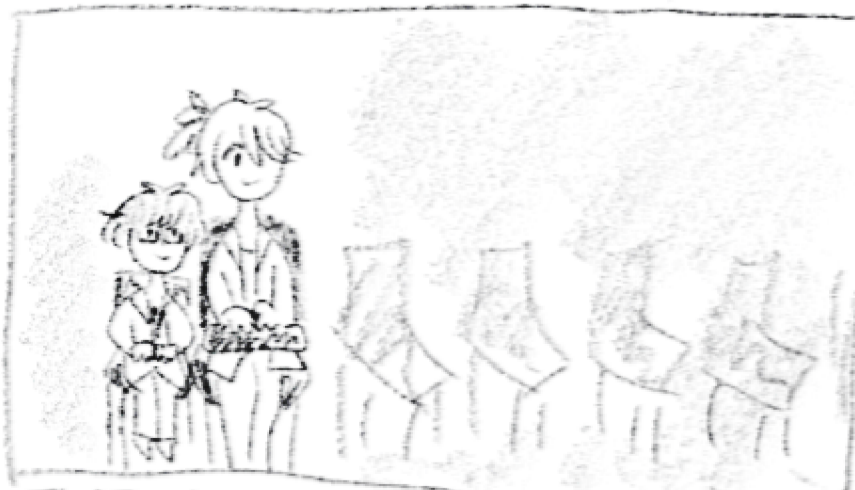


HE CHECKED IN...

THEY'LL SAY THINGS, BUT...



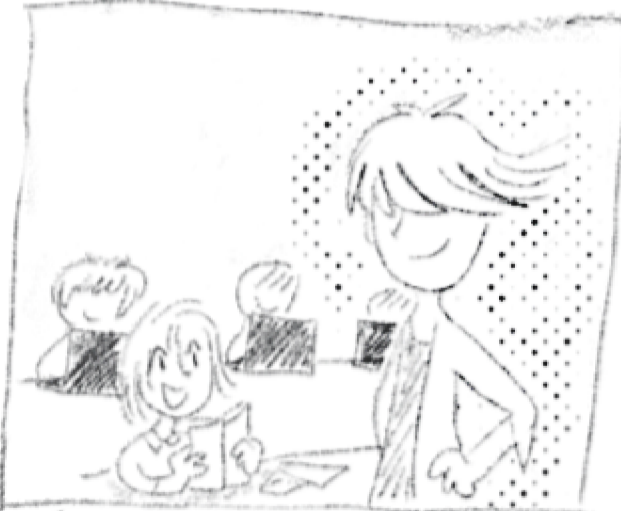
AND I WANTED TO EVEN MORE...

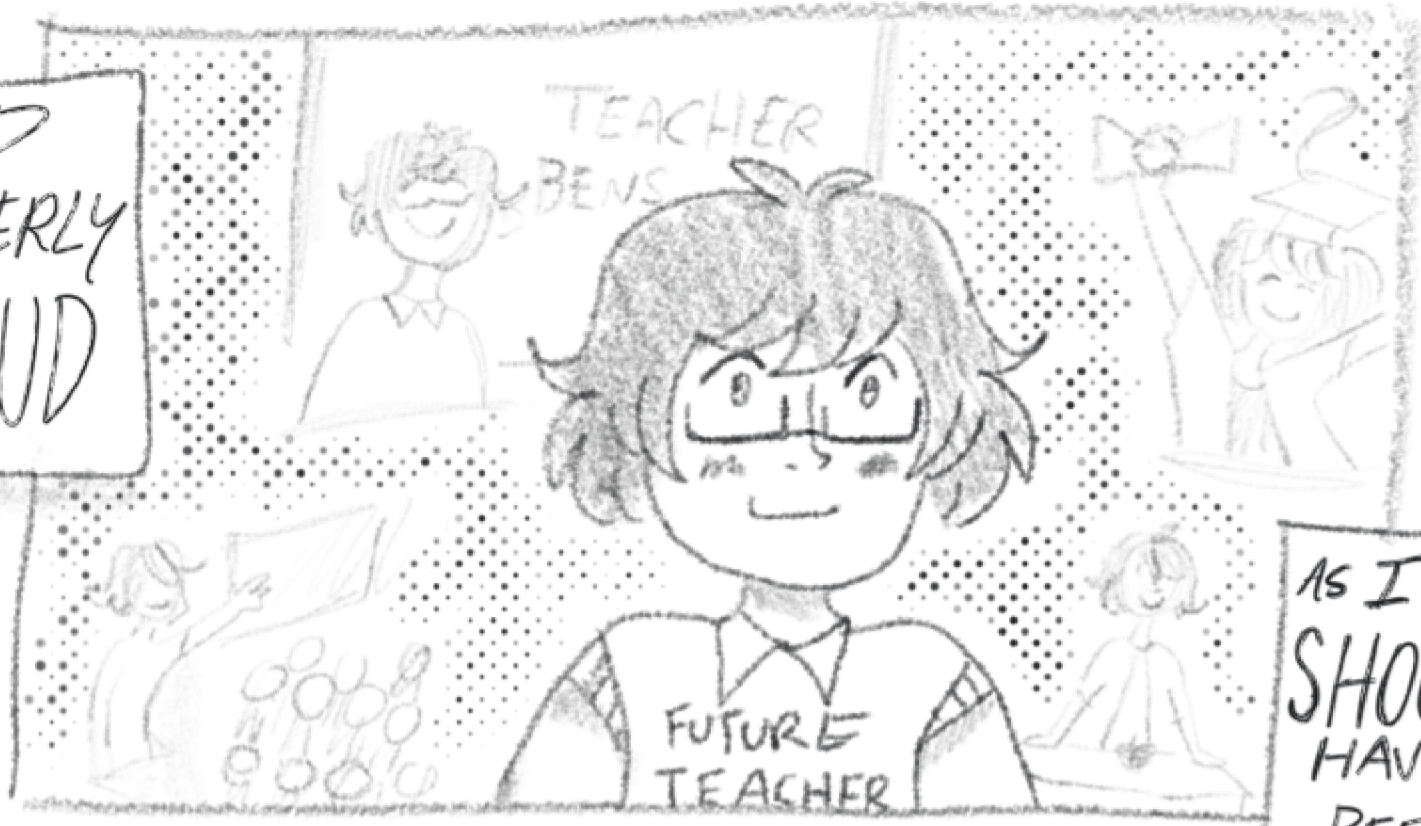
WHERE I QUIT THINKING ABOUT WHAT MADE ME SHY OF SHARING MY MAJOR...

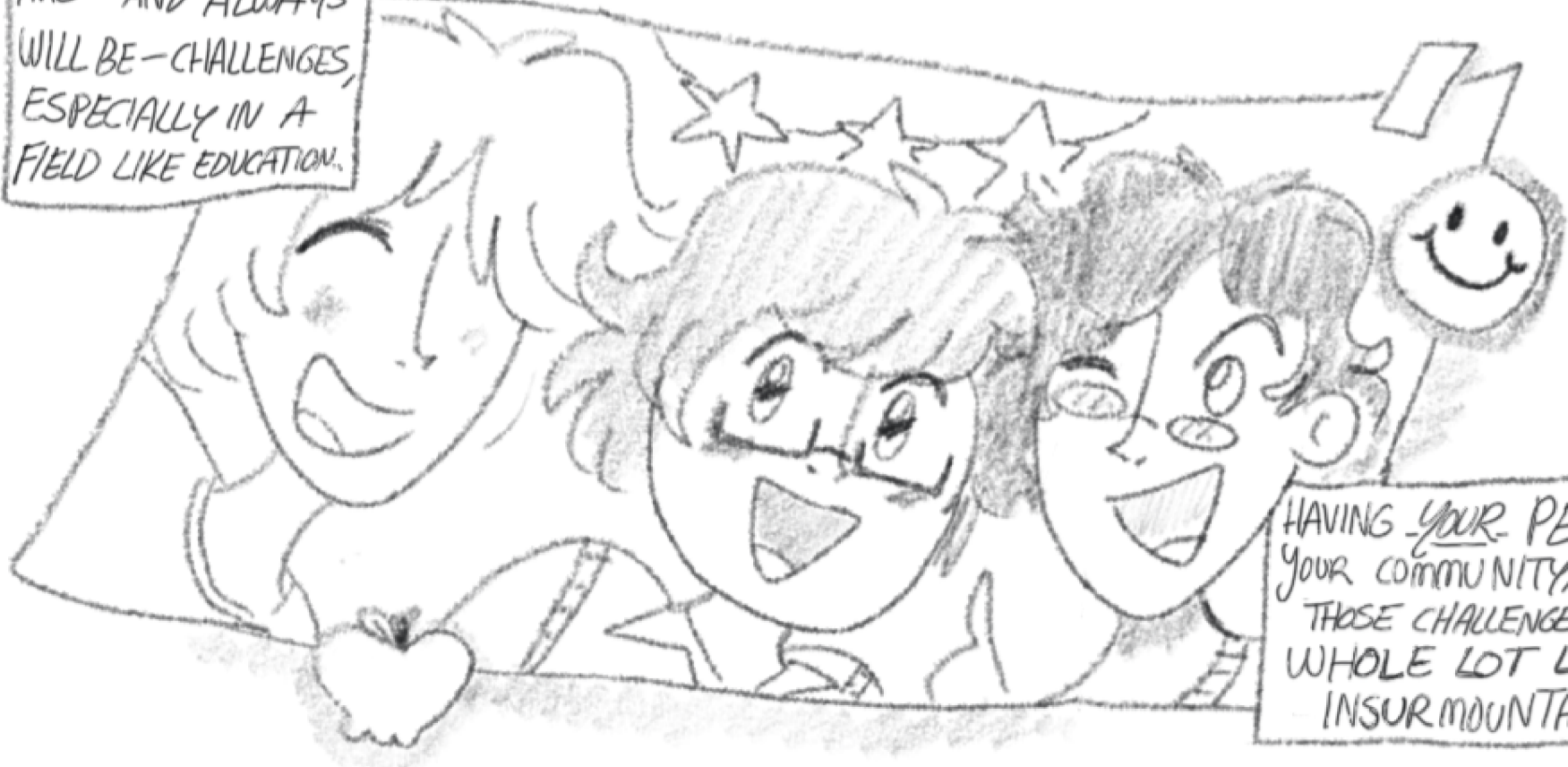

GUYS, RELAX. THESE AREN'T STRANGERS, THEY ARE FROM THE LOCAL COLLEGE!



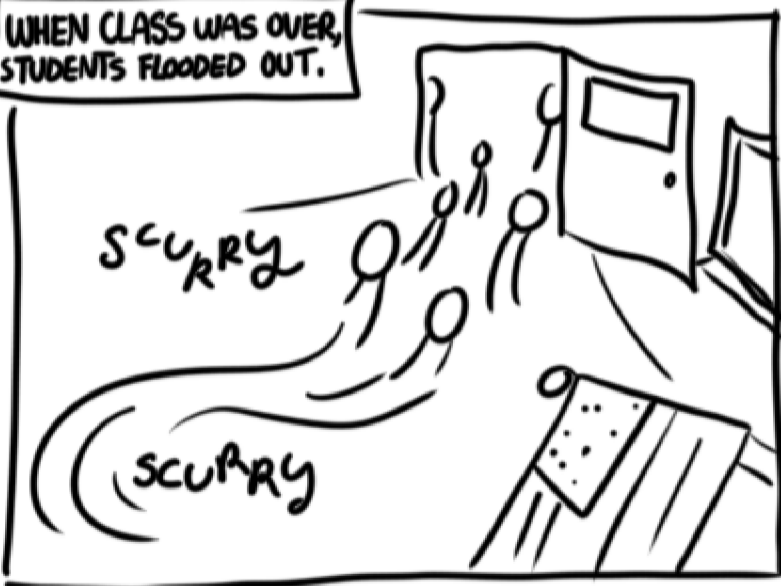
THEY ARE STRANGERS, THOUGH
