What's a zine?

Zines (pronounced 'zeen') are self-published booklets, or small magazines.

Why should I make a zine?

★ ★

Zines are cool! They're personal, concise, and hugely varied. You don't need specialized equipment or skills to make one. They're a great way to share your art + writing.

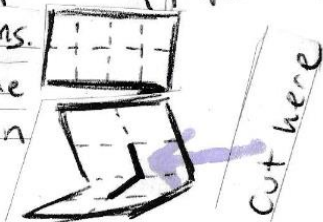
How do I make zines?

Longer zines are more complicated. 8 page mini zines - like this one - are a great place to start. Zines can be handwritten, typed, stencilled, collaged, anything! ★

How to fold an 8 page zine:

① Divide a piece of paper into 8 sections.

② cut along the middle section

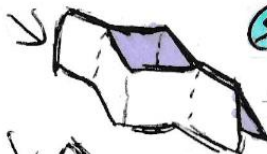


③ Fold length ways



④ Push the edges

in, so the hole creates a diamond shape



⑤ Continue until the hole creates an X shape



⑥ Gather the pages together



7 Fold along the 'spine' of your zine and it's done! ★
