

ANARCHOPUNK BY BIRTH, POP BY CHOICE, ONE HIT WONDERS BY THE GRACE OF GOD.

THERE ARE A MILLION DIFFERENT PICTURES OF WHO CHUMBAWAMBA ARE OR WHAT IT IS,

AND ALL OF THEM ARE INCOMPLETE. I GO BACK AND FORTH ABOUT EVERY BAND, BUT HERE'S WHAT I LIKE ABOUT THEM.

### FOLK

CHUMBAWAMBA CARED ABOUT THE FOLK MUSIC TRADITIONS OF BRITAIN, TO THE EXTENT THAT I'D SAY THEY WERE REAL FOLK PUNKS. EXCUSE ME IF I'M ONLY IGNORANT, BUT I DON'T SEE MUCH FOLK IN "FOLK PUNK", JUST ACOUSTIC GUITARS AND THE ODD BILLY BRAGG REFERENCE. CHUMBAWAMBA, ON THE OTHER HAND, DID A LITTLE BIT MORE HOMEWORK THAN YER AVERAGE MOUNTAIN GOAT OR WHATEVER -- LISTEN TO ENGLISH REBEL SONGS OR READYMADES FOR PROOF. CHUMBAWAMBA WERE LITERATE IN THE TRADITION THEY DREW FROM, WHILE AT THE SAME TIME SYNTHESISING IT WITH THEIR PUNK AND POP HERITAGE.
THEORY (INO) CHUMBAWAMBA LIKED FOLK MUSIC FOR ITS AESTHETIC BUT ALSO FOR ITS SOCIAL

ROLE:A FORM OF ART THAT EXISTED OUTSIDE OF ANY INSTITUTIONS, BY AND FOR ORDINARY

PEOPLE, ART THAT WAS ALSO A HISTORY BOOK OR A POLITICAL MANIFESTO. IT GELLED WITH THEIR

ATTEMPTS TO SOLVE A MAJOR PUNK PROBLEM: CREATING MUSIC THAT WAS RADICAL IN BOTH FORM

AND IN CONTENT, BUT WHICH ALSO REMAINED WITHIN A RECOGNISABLE TRADITION. LIKE THE

CLASH, THEY TRIED TO SOLVE THIS PROBLEM BY INTRODUCING A DIVERSITY OF STYLES, AND

STRUGGLING TO SYNTHESISE THEM. AT TIMES, THEY FAILED TO DO THAT, AND AT TIMES THEY MAY

HAVE SUCCEEDED AT SYNTHESISING DIFFERENT TRADITIONS BUT FAILED TO CREATE SOMETHING

LISTENABLE. PASSION

SUPPORTED BY THEFERENT LABELS AND DEACH PURK TIMES. THEY TAKEN THENSELVES TO DEAL HOUSE AND DEPENDENT.

SUPPORTED BY INDEPENDENT LABELS AND PEACE PUNK ZINES, THEY TAUGHT THEMSELVES TO PLAY, WRITE AND PERFORM THEIR HUSIC, AT ONE POINT ALSO RUNNING THEIR OWN RECORD LABEL. ## The Good: Teenage Cics (TV, 2006)

An Irish comedy-drama that follows three siblings during their stay at a Donegal Irish college during the summer of 1985. The soundtrack is banging, the plots are a bit weird and you're never quite sure if it's aimed at kids or adults. What more could you want? ## The Ugly: I Was A Teenage Serial Killer

(Movie, 1993) spoiler alert!!!

This short film follows a girl with murder on her mind as she kills her way across the country. "I've killed 19 men," she says, "One for every year I've been alive". Each onscreen murder is prompted by sexism: the male relative who tells her to stop sleeping around, the catcaller, the cute boy who takes the condom off. Why "ugly"? The murder scenes are often genuinely shocking (despite the fake blood) and, in one case, seemed disturbingly sexualised. That, and the refusal of the director to gloss over the violence of the deaths, make this a difficult watch, although our hero abandons her violent coping mechanism in the final frames. A point in its favour: the (riot grrl and queercore) soundtrack is banging.
