This plant comes from southern China and is often called the friendship plant due to how easy it is to grow from clippings and share.

Scientific Name:
Pilea Peperomioides

Indirect Sunlight

HOW TO KEEP ME ALIVE



Soil Type: Houseplant compost and perlite. Well drained



Watering: Every 1-2 weeks. Leaves droop more than normal when over watered



Repotting: Once a year or as needed when roots show under the pot

This plant can quickly grows tall. Find a corner for them.

Calathea Rattlesnake



This plant is native to Brazil. The underside of the leaves are purple and the fold together at night like in prayer. These plants need higher humidity levels.

Scientific Name:
Goeppertia insignis

Indirect Sunlight

HOW TO KEEP ME ALIVE



Soil Type: Potting mix. Light and sandy. Well drained



Watering: Only when topsoil feels dry. Yellow leaves mean over watered



Repotting: As needed or when roots show under the pot

This plant stays relatively small and looks nice as a centerpiece

HOW TO KEEP ME ALIVE

Soil Type: Peat soil is best but can tolerate loamy. Well drained

Watering: Water to keep soil damp. Slimy yellow leaves when over watered

Repotting: Every other year, roots are ok to be tightly packed

This plant can grow tall and adds a green touch to any decor

Scientific Name:
Chamaedorea elegans

This plant is native to the rainforests of Guatemala and Mexico. They can live in dark corners of your home and can produce small fruit. Don't eat them! Remove them.
