 Type: Mammals  
 Diet: Herbivore  
 Life Span: 40 years  
 Size: 8-13 feet  
 Weight: 440 to 1,300 pounds  
 Lamatees are very social animals and live with others as a herd.



**Torilla**

Type: Reptammalian  
 Diet: Omnivore  
 Life Span: 35 to 100 years or more  
 Size: 4 feet  
 Weight: 300 to 485 pounds

Torillas care for their eggs in small family groups, taking turns keeping them warm.



**Toadat**

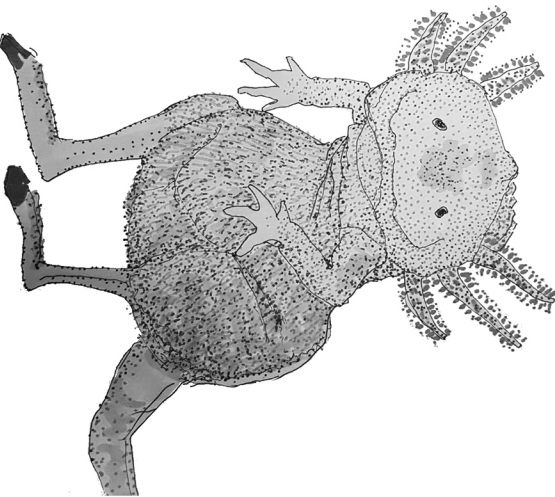
Type: Reptammalian  
 Diet: Omnivore  
 Life Span: 3-5 years  
 Size: 6-9 inches  
 Weight: 5-6 pounds

The Toadat (sometimes known as a Ratoad) is the most common of all endangered animals.



**Horned Frug**

Type: Invertephibian  
 Diet: Carnivore  
 Life Span: Up to 5 years  
 Size: 0.25 to 12 inches weight: Up to 3.3 pounds  
 The Horned Frug tadpole metamorphose into almost fully formed Frugs in 12 to 60 days. The horns take another 20 days to grow in.



**Axolaroo**

Type: Marsuphian  
 Diet: Omnivore  
 Life Span: Up to 23 years  
 Size: 3.25 - 5.25 feet  
 Weight: 30 - 40 pounds

The Axolaroo is capable of regrowing body parts and can jump 7 feet in the air.



**Buzzilla**

Type: Mammertabrate  
 Diet: Omnivore  
 Life Span: Up to 5 to 10 years  
 Size: Up to 9 to 10 inches  
 Weight: Up to 8 to 10 pounds

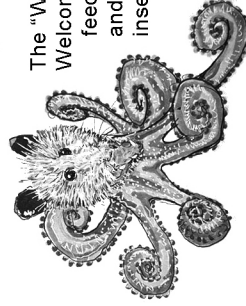
Several hundred drones live in the hive but many are expelled in the lean winter months.



**The Why**

Type: Mammertabrate  
 Diet: Carnivore  
 Life Span: Up to 10 years  
 Size: 0.75 inches to 2 feet  
 Weight: Up to 3 pounds

The "World's Most Welcome House Guest" feeds on bed bugs and other small insects.



**Octoshrew**

Type: Mammertabrate  
 Diet: Omnivore  
 Life Span: 1 to 2 years  
 Size: Up to 12 inches  
 Weight: Up to 10 pounds

Octoshrews are solitary creatures.



**Lemullar**

Type: Mammertabrate  
 Diet: Omnivore  
 Life Span: Up to 8 years  
 Size: Up to 14 inches  
 Weight: 3 to 5.5 pounds

The Lemurillar does not pupate after the larva stage. Core groups of females settle into a feeding spot (generally a good tree).
